

115gsm Knitted Polyester	Our standard flag material.	Suitable for flying in winds up to 25mph.	ldeal for medium term usage.	Suitable for all mirror image flag types.	
115gsm Polymesh	A permeable material, allowing wind to pass through.	Suitable for flying in winds up to 38mph.	50% more durable than Knitted Polyester. Medium to long term use.	Suitable for all mirror image flag types.	
Spun Polyester	Traditional flag material, approved by the MOD for their Navy flags.	Suitable for flying in winds up to 38mph.	50% more durable than Knitted Polyester. Medium to long term use.	Suitable for all flag types.	
Endurance Polyester	A modern fabric that is extremely durable.	Suitable for flying in winds up to 38mph.	100% more durable than Knitted Polyester. Long term use.	Suitable for all flag types.	
210gsm Heavy Knitted Polyester	A thicker fabric that creates a more blockout effect.	Suitable for flying in winds up to 25mph.	ldeal for medium term usage.	Suitable for all flag types.	
235gsm Blockout Polyester	Our heaviest fabric that creates an opaque display.	Suitable for flying in winds up to 25mph.	ldeal for medium term usage.	Suitable for double sided flags on banner arms or angled flags.	

- It is important that your flag is able to fly unobstructed.
- Exposure to the sun can affect the colour of your flag.
- High winds and heavy rain will affect the durability of your flag. Pollution in the air will quickly dirty your flag and gradually damage the material.
- Flags should not be flown in high winds.

Rope & Toggle	Ideal for most flags with any type of flagpole.	×	<b>✓</b>	
Sleeve & Eyelet	ldeal for flags being flown on a flagpole with a banner arm.	<b>✓</b>	<b>✓</b>	
Anti Fray Netting	Helps to increase the durability of your flag. The antifray will fray before the edge of the flag does.	<b>✓</b>	<b>✓</b>	
Flitemaster	An alternative to a banner arm. The flitemaster is sewn into the flag to help ensure it is always on display.	<b>✓</b>	×	
Flag Weight	Ideal for flags being flown on an aluminium flagpole. The weight helps to keep tension in the flag.	<b>✓</b>	<b>✓</b>
